• Student-Led Conferences are November 19 and November 20 from 9 AM - 8 PM. At this point, you should have heard from your child's Advisory teacher either by email, phone call, or a paper handout being sent home. Please contact your student's Advisory teacher or the office at 503-916-5660 if this is not the case. We are scheduling conferences every half hour (except 11:30 AM - 12 PM and 5 PM - 6 PM) with the first conference being at 9 AM and the last conference scheduled at 7:30 PM. Advisors are hosting conferences and students are expected to come so that they can present and lead the conference where they will share their strengths, grades, MAP data, behavior report, action steps, and goals for the school year. Did you know that your child can get no cost medical care at the Jefferson Student Health Center? It is open to all K-12 aged youth in Multnomah County. See us for medical care four days a week during the school year. Half of appointments are reserved for same day, so it is easy to get in if your child is sick, injured, or just needs a regular check up.
