

DA VINCI RECOMMENDED SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Students need a few essential supplies to be prepared for success each day. Students will use their **lockers to store backpacks, lunch boxes, dance clothes, cellphones, extra supplies**, etc. They need something that can be easily carried from class to class. We suggest a **zippered 2 inch binder with 3-hole punch** and separate tabs for each class and a pencil pouch for a few essentials.

Students also carry their school approved Chromebooks throughout the day, not personal laptop devices. They can use a separate school-provided case or an integrated binder laptop case but they should use something to keep the device protected.

If students bring a phone to school, it should be shut off and kept away in their backpacks or lockers during the day.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Binder or system to carry classroom essentials ● Your PPS approved Chromebook, charged and ready to go - need to use the school case or other protective sleeve ● Dividers or separate folders for core classes ● Pencil pouch with extra sharpened pencils, a fine tip sharpie, a few pens, a few highlighters ● 2-3 Composition notebooks, depending on the teacher (NOT spiral notebooks). ● College-ruled, loose-leaf paper ● 1 graph paper composition book for math ● Refillable water bottle with a good lid 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Extra pencils ● Basic set of colored pencils and/or markers ● Glue stick ● Hand held eraser ● Small scissors ● Index cards ● Sticky notes ● Personal items ● Jackets ● Cell phones <p>Note- Lunch boxes and snacks should be removed daily. Please, no storing food in lockers.</p>
