Faubion Standard Dress Requirements:

Tops: Navy blue, white, and red. Solid colors with collar (turtlenecks count) and either short or long sleeve. Bare waists, bare midriffs, bare backs and low necklines are not permitted.

<u>Sweaters and sweatshirts</u> must be navy blue, white, or red. The collar from the shirt underneath must be showing.



Bottoms: Shorts, pants, skirts, jumpers, skorts, capris must be khaki/tan, black or navy._ Bottoms must be plain, non-patterned. Denim jeans are <u>not</u> included. Belts suggested for belt loops. Bottoms should fit properly and not sag below the waist. Shorts may be no more than 2 inches above the knee and may not be below the knee. *Leggings are permitted underneath skirts only.*

Socks, Tights: Tights must be solid colors, either khaki/tan, black, white or navy. Socks may be of any color and/or pattern. Leggings are to be worn under skirts only.

Shoes: Shoes must be closed toe. Sandals need to have a heel strap (no slides or flip flops). Boots are permitted. Heels may not be taller than one inch.

<u>Coats</u>: Coats may be of any color or style but may not be worn inside the classroom.

<u>Hats:</u> Hats, hoodies, beanies, etc. may not be worn in the building. Only religious head coverings are allowed.

<u>Swag</u>: Students may wear Faubion, Concordia or 3 to PhD gear, that is not modified, any day. If students are in swag, t-shirts without a collar are acceptable. Tank tops may not be worn.

Faubion School will also be launching a thriving clothing closet where families may pick up low-cost/no cost uniform pieces. We also encourage Faubion families to donate outgrown uniform pieces to our clothing closet. If you are interested in helping to launch or help staff our clothing closet, please contact the front office and let us know!

When students come to school without their uniform, the policy is:

** First Time: Student will go to the office and receive a "temporary uniform" to change in to. The family will receive a reminder note to have their student attend school in standard dress. The family will be asked to sign and return this reminder note. At the end of the day, the student will change back into their "free dress clothes" and we will wash the borrowed uniform pieces.

** Second Time: Student will go to the office and receive a "temporary uniform" to change in to. Student will call parent, who in turn will have to bring a uniform to school so that the student can change.
