#### **CLASS DESCRIPTION**

Bravo, Campfire, African Club, Hacienda, and Asian Pacific Islander club facilitate their own enrollment and recruitment.

#### Homework Club: (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday) (4:15-5:10)

Gives students opportunity to start or even complete their homework before heading home. We will have payed staff and volunteers that will come in and help students with all subjects.

## Hand Drumming: (Tuesdays)(5:15-6:10)

Learn how to play traditional Djembe African drums. You will learn traditional African rhythms and tempo.

# Photography: (Mondays) (5:15-6:10)

Discover the world around us. Beginning students learn the basic controls on digital cameras and tips to enhance pictures using different functions such as ISO, aperture and shutter speed. They discuss composition, lighting and perspective and learn how to best capture an image regardless of the lighting or weather conditions.

## Art & Design(Wednesdays) (5:15-6:10)

Students will explore a variety of artists, art processes and materials such as drawing, painting, printmaking, two & three-dimensional design, and digital art.

## Oregon Battle of the Books OBOB(Thursday)(4:15-5:10)

Oregon Battle of the Books (OBOB) is a voluntary reading motivation and comprehension. Students in 3<sup>rd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade, regardless of ability, are exposed to quality literature representing a variety of literary styles and viewpoints. A student participates by reading from the book list provided for that year's Oregon Battle of the Books. Discusses book titles and competes in battles with their teammates.

# Tongan Dance (Thursdays)(4:15-6:10)

Come and learn about the Tongan culture and learn about its traditional dance.

#### Leadership & Team Building(Mondays & Wednesdays)(5:15-6:10)

Students will participate in activities and discussion that will enhance their leadership skills and abilities to work together as a team. They will have the chance to improve their ability for collaboration, creativity, communication and reinforce positive relationships.

## Creating Hip-Hop Music (Tuesday) (4:15-5:10)

Put your poetry to music! You will write your own poetry, making your own beats, display what you had learned and made during the class.

# Hip-Hop – Popping: (Tuesday) (4:15pm-5:10pm)

A freestyle street dance in which a dancer uses their muscles and body to accent the beat. Closely related to Hip-Hop dance we will focus on waving, tutting, hitting, robot, grooving and having fun.

# MBA Basketball:(Tuesday &Thursday) (4:15-5:10)OR (5:15-6:10)

Come learn from highly knowledgeable current and former basketball players, whose skills and expertise will provide unique training techniques for each student. This class focuses on developing both fundamentals and skills for players while having a great time doing it!

### AKA Science and Kitchen Chemistry: (Tuesday, Thursday) (5:15-6:10)

Want to get a reaction? Use chemistry to change the world! Transform regular liquids into a bubbling lava lamp and make a container burst into the air! Investigate fake snow, mix up some flubber, and explore awesome acids and bases...then take stuff home to amaze your family and friends!
