Attendance: Welcome back to school! School attendance is very important. Did you know:

- Students who miss 10% of the school year (or 17 days throughout the year) are considered chronically absent
- This number includes excused AND unexcused absences
- Missing 10% or more of the school year can make it harder to learn to read

- Attendance is one of the three school success indicators reflected in our school's report card issued yearly by the state
- When students reduce absences, they can make great academic gains

Important Cafeteria Information:

Starting this school year, the kitchen will be offering each student the opportunity to receive one breakfast for free and to purchase one lunch per day. **Students will now be able to purchase milk ala carte again.**

This new process supports the District's wellness policy, as well as Portland's sustainability efforts. Students are encouraged to bring beverages from home to support the school community's desire to reduce milk carton waste. This new policy will also help reduce confusion around use of school meal funds on the student's account (for example, charging additional meals and/or milk without parent knowledge and approval). We will continue providing cups for water and unlimited fruits and veggies for students purchasing school lunch.
