Inclement Weather:

Delays and closures: The district has two options in the event of bad weather: Delay school openings for two hours or close the schools altogether. Before deciding which to do, district officials consult with local meteorologists, city transportation officials and PPS transportation staff in the field. This information will be on the local television news and broadcast through PPS alerts. If there were a two hour late opening due to weather, students scheduled start time would then be 9:50AM. Parking and Drop Off Reminder

There is no parking in front of the school. If you pull up in front of the school, the driver must remain in the car. If you want to walk your child into the building, please park on a side street such as 30th or 31st and walk to the school. Thank you in advance for supporting drop off at the front of the school.

Free Lunch – Families Can Apply at Any Time

While the Nutrition Services department has processed thousands of applications for free/reduced price meal benefits for families this fall and many others were directly certified (eligible) because they received SNAP benefits, we are finding that families who were eligible last year may not have reapplied this school year. On October 10, all families who were eligible last school year (2018-19) and did not reapply this school year, switched from free/reduced status to paid status. It is not too late! If your family's financial situation has changed midyear, you can still apply throughout the school year. Please note that the USDA Child Nutrition Programs are not subject to the "Public Charge" and will not jeopardize anyone's immigration status:

From the <u>US Citizenship and Immigration Services Website</u>: Any benefits not listed not in the rule are excluded from consideration. Notably, the rule does not include consideration of emergency medical assistance, disaster relief, national school lunch programs, foster care and adoption, student and mortgage loans, energy assistance, food pantries and homeless shelters and Head Start.
