## **Important Reminders:**

- SUN School schedules were sent home today electronically and in backpacks. Coach Chelsea did her best, but she was not able to honor every request this term. She is keeping track and next term will prioritize those who didn't get in this time.
- Picture Day is next Wednesday, October 13. Orders can be placed online or with the packet that was sent home. If you are ordering with the packet, the form and payment must be returned on picture day. Pictures will be taken in the auditorium at a social distance of at least six feets. Students will wait in the hallway until it is their turn. Students may take their pictures with or without masks.
- Dental Screening Forms were sent home and will continue to be accepted until the day of the screening.
- Just a friendly reminder please do not send students to school with medicine in their backpacks. If students need to take medication during school hours, parents/guardians must complete a form and deliver the medication directly to the office, School Health Assistant, or Nurse.

### **Health & Safety Protocols and Reminders**

- We submitted our first batch of OHSU Covid Screening Opt-In forms. It takes OHSU approximately 7-10 days to process the forms and assign a start date. We are hoping this will happen by October 21, but we will let you know when that is confirmed. We know that kits will be sent home on Wednesdays and collected on Thursdays. More information will be sent home as we get closer to our start date. We are still collecting and processing forms if you would like your child to participate.
- We will continue to eat lunch outdoors as long as the weather permits. We make this decision first thing in the morning based on weather predictions for the day. We moved to six feet social distancing, both indoors and outdoors, while students are eating with their masks off. Also, we will have recess outside as much as possible. Please help students remember their sweatshirts or coats.
