## **Calculators**

6th grade and 7th grade core math each requires a general calculator. Compacted 7<sup>th</sup> grade math and all 8th grade math requires a scientific calculator, i.e., TI-30XIIS, TI 34 or TI 36. TI-84 Graphing Calculator for 8th graders is optional (students will use this calculator through college). Graph paper notebooks are required for all students in all grades. These notebooks can be purchased through the school for \$4, which is substantially less than retail prices.
