School Psychologist

Hi, my name is Chelyn Joseph and I am happy to serve as the James John school psychologist. This is my tenth year at James John and my 22nd year as a school psychologist. I was privileged to teach special education for five years prior to becoming a school psychologist, which was great background for what I do now.

I have many responsibilities as a school psychologist including:

- Evaluating students to determine if they are in need of special education supports.
- Identifying mental health supports for students.
- Identifying academic supports for students.
- Consulting with teachers and families.
- Consulting with professionals in the community such as medical providers and mental health providers.
- Advocating for resources for students.
- Creating individualized plans to support student's behavior.
- Counseling.
- Fostering communication between home and school.
- Working to create healthy school systems.
- Collaborating to help make the learning environments productive, safe and accessible for students who struggle.

I am at James John four days a week – Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. My office is room 23. I am often out in classrooms or working with kiddos, but if my "WELCOME" sign is out that means you can stop by to see me.

Thursdays I do the same job at MLK Jr school.


