MUC 170 -- **Beat and Basics**. Tues/Thurs 1:00-2:50 PM. This course assumes little or no musical training and introduces students to industry standard, pro technologies used in creating contemporary beats, bass lines, melodies and harmonies. It is best for students who like computers and musical genres wherein electronic instruments are common (pop, hip hop, rap, EDM etc.). The instructor is Lorna Milgaten.

MUC 274 -- **Microcontrollers for Artists**. Monday/Wednesday 6:00-7:50 PM. This course assumes little or no experience with creative coding or microcontrollers. Students learn to construct and program microcontrollers for artistic purposes (controlling sound, lights, lasers, video etc.). Class is very hands-on. The instructor is Jesse Mejia.

MUC 101 -- **Commercial Music Theory**. Tues/Thurs 2:00-3:20 PM. This course assumes little or no prior musical training. Students learn the fundamentals of music theory as it applies to contemporary musical genres. The instructor is Sarah Gaskins.

MUC 223. **Studio Recording I**. Tues/Thurs 10:00-11:50 AM. This course assumes little or no prior recording experience. Students learn the fundamentals of studio recording and music production. The instructor is Jeffrey Brice.
