WHAT IS HAPPENING AND WHY

Due to changes at the federal level, the Community Eligibility Program will end at Jason Lee.

WHAT IS THE IMPACT TO YOUR FAMILY

To see if your family can qualify for Free or Reduced meal benefits, please submit a meal application <u>after</u> July 1, 2017. There will be a 30 day grace period at the start of the school year to allow families additional time to submit an application. Meals during this grace period would be at no cost to your family. Also, if you have new students in your household attending this fall, like an incoming kindergartener, please let us know who they are as they are eligible for the 30 day grace period as well.

Families have two options to submit a meal application:

- 1. Online: https://schoolmealapp.com. Families can either use a computer or download the SchoolCafe app on any mobile device. Those who submit an application with the mobile app will have access to view the status of their meal application.
- Paper: Request a copy from your student's school, or download online: https://www.pps.net/nutrition

If your family is ineligible or the meal application is not approved, meal charges would begin on October 12, 2017. You can provide a meal from home, or pay for school meals with cash, check, or debit/credit card online at www.schoolcafe.com. There is a 5% convenience fee per online transaction.
