
### **Expected Outcomes**

- ✓ Create an appropriately sized K-5 school
- ✓ Provide improved access to a full middle school program for Lee students
- Consolidate at one school an income-controlled housing development that had been split between two schools
- Leave adequate building space for enrollment and program growth

### **Proposed Boundary Change**



Boundary Changes were rolled out this week for the proposed Roseway Heights Middle School. Above is a map of how that would impact Jason Lee's boundaries, drawing more students from the Roseway Neighborhood.

This past week I attended a board meeting and listening sessions at both Roseway Heights and Madison High School where Jason Lee parents and community members, in addition to those from other schools, were able to give feedback to the proposed boundary changes and middle school implementation plan. You can find those documents attached if you would like to review them. Our parents spoke passionately about their love for Lee and their desire to have an equitable middle school where students would have a greater variety of elective courses and class offerings. We look forward to seeing that plan take shape under the new planning principal, Kathleen Ellwood, previously the principal of Irvington.
