**Live:** Also known as Synchronous Learning, students will participate in live classes with their teacher and classmates. Teachers will use a variety of strategies to present content, have student practice with the work, and develop their skills.

**AL:** Also known as **Asynchronous Learning**, during these blocks the teacher is available and may start out class with a whole class check in, and then students work on content. Teachers are available for the first 45 min of the class to help students.

**Small Group Instruction (SGI):** During Asynchronous Learning, teachers may pull students into small group learning to provide challenge, enrichment, support or extra instruction.

**Applied Learning:** Learning time where students are online, actively engaged in completing work, practicing with content, preparing for lessons, and/or are working with other students.

**Office Hours:** When teachers are free for students to “drop in” to ask questions or get additional assistance.

**Live Classes:** Students will be marked present for participating in the class

**AL/SGI:** Students will be marked present for participating in video check ins, small group learning, posting work to Canvas, or communicating with teachers directly.

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## How will I be graded?










Classes will be graded with a letter grade. With the 4x4 schedule, you will earn 0.5 credits for your 4 classes each quarter. Teachers will prioritize grading assignments tied to core content standards.
