


## Patricia Gallagher Picture Book Award

The award is named for Patricia Gallagher, a retired Western Oregon University professor of children's literature and former OSLA president.



#### About the Award

The award was founded in 1997 as a way to promote literacy and a love of reading...one of the goals of the Oregon State Literacy Association. The books are chosen by a committee of OSLA leaders, teachers, school and public librarians. Titles must be readily available in paperback, be no more than ten years old, hold an innate appeal to children, have quality text and illustrations, and work well as a readaloud.

#### Who May Vote?

Oregon school children of all ages are eligible to vote. Each child votes for their favorite book. This is not a group/class vote.

#### When to Vote

Voting occurs between September 1st and May 1st. Votes must be reported by **May 1, 2022.**
