School Breakfast & Lunch

2018/19 Lunch Costs

In May 22, the school Board voted and approved a 10 cent increase in lunch prices for the 2018-19 school year. Lunch for students not on free or reduced lunch will be \$2.90.

Free and Reduced Lunch

To apply for free or reduced lunch for the 2018/19 school year go to https://schoolcafe.com/. A student ID is needed, and can found on the student profile, an old report card, and is the same as the student's lunch number. If you do not have access to the internet paper copies are available in the office.

If you had free and reduced lunch last year, there is a grace period to turn in your form for this year. In this case, you have until October 8th. Applications must be approved by this date. Starting October 9th, all students regardless of their previous status will accrue balances.

The copay for reduced price eligible meals will continue to be covered by the state of Oregon in 2018-19 and these meals will remain at no charge to the students.

Breakfast

Peninsula School continues to offer free breakfast to all students. If adults wish to puchase a breakfast the cost will be \$2.25.
