Drop-off and Pick-up

Drop-Off

Breakfast doors open (breakfast served)*:	7:45am
Teachers pick students up from the cafeteria:	7:55am
Tardy Bell (student's must be in class at this time):	8:00am
Students are tardy and must report to office:	8:00am (and later)

***New morning arrival routine:** All students will enter the set of double doors south of the cafeteria doors (to the left if you are looking at the cafeteria doors). Students will go through the cafeteria line for breakfast.

Pick-up

Dismissal:	2:15pm
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Kindergarten students are picked up on the northwest end of the school outside of their classrooms on the playground. Grades 1 and 2 are dismissed on the front porch. Grades 3-5 will be dismissed in front of the school from the door on the south side of the cafeteria. Teachers will walk students out and students who walk home can do so.

All school volunteers must have a completed and approved background check. It only takes a few minutes to apply online and once approved it is good for 3 years. It can take 3-4 weeks for applications to be approved at the beginning of the year, so submit your application as soon as possible. You will be notified of it's completion via email.

Free and Reduced Lunch Application: www.SchoolCafe.com

One Free and reduced lunch application need to be completed per family, per year. Applications completed online are processed more quickly than paper applications. If the student is not approved before the first day of school they will have to pay full price until it has been approved. Paper copies of the application can be found in the school office.

Student's school lunch accounts have a new host site this year, School Café. Funds can be added and managed online by going to their website. Cash or checks can be delivered directly to the cafeteria.
