Peninsula is going Tech Smart!!

Peninsula has received a Tech Smart grant from the Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission supporting literacy development through the use of technology.

The grant has provided us with technology carts for each k-3 classroom, that include one new Chromebook for every two students. It also purchased us an adaptive reading instructional program called Core 5 and an extensive online reading library called MyOn that all Peninsula students will be able to access both at school and home (with internet service). All Peninsula students will be learning how to use these programs to support their ongoing literacy progress. Teachers will be using them to supplement the new literacy adoption and to monitor student progress.

One thing however that the grant *did not include* was headphones, which are necessary for each student to have to use the programs. We are hoping that many students will be able to bring their own. If you are interested in providing extras we would graciously accept your help. You may also donate to the headset fund via SchoolPay or in the school.

It can take 3-4 weeks for applications to be approved at the beginning of the year, so submit your application as soon as possible. You will be notified of it's completion via email.

One Free and reduced lunch application need to be completed per family, per year. Applications completed online are processed more quickly than paper applications. If the student is not approved before the first day of school they will have to pay full price until it has been approved. Paper copies of the application can be found in the school office.
