Come one, come all to the Peninsula Family Bazaar

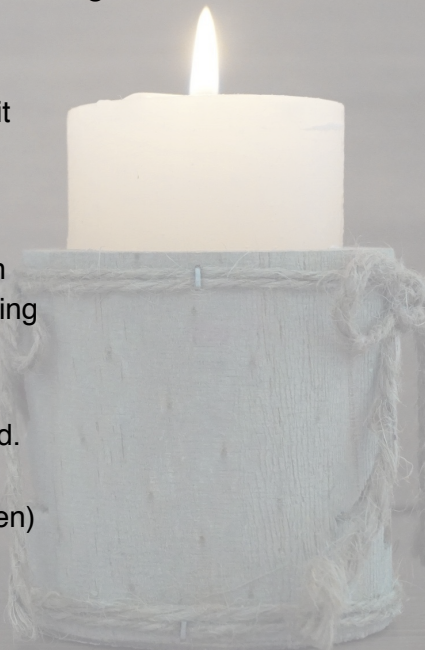
**Saturday, December 2nd
