Benefit

This mobile app is replacing Roseway Heights' SCRIP card program, which is a PTA fundraiser that helps offset field trip expenses. It's very easy to use on your smart phone, and all you need are 5 minutes to download and set up your payment options. Here's how it works:



- ① Download the app onto your phone. It's called **Benefit Mobile**. Choose Roseway Heights as the organization you'd like to "benefit" from the purchases you make.
- ② Enter a bank account number. Enter a credit card number. BOTH will earn a percentage for the school, although a bank account yields a higher percentage to the school.
- ③ Buy a gift card. Many of the gift cards you can buy and use right on your phone. Make sure it's not an "online" or "print out" card if you are planning to use it on your phone. It usually says right on the screen how you can use it before you buy it.
- ④ You can have the cashier ring you up and buy a gift card on your phone while you are in line at many stores for close to the exact amount. It makes it easy to not overspend on a card you may only use once.
