## COLLEGE ATHLETES

If you intend to participate in Division I or II athletics as a freshman in college, you must be registered with and certified as eligible by the NCAA Initial-Eligibility Clearinghouse. This was implemented by the NCAA to ensure consistent interpretation of initial NCAA requirements for incoming freshman. ACT or SAT scores are mandatory for Division I schools. Core courses are required and are verified by the Clearinghouse. Juniors should take the SAT test on March 12 or May 7 and could retake as a senior in October.

Start planning now if you plan to participate in athletics at the college level. See your counselor for more information or if you have questions about the application process.
