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# NEW CONSTRUCTION PROJECT ON SW 10<sup>TH</sup> AVE NEAR SW CHESTNUT

The Portland Water Bureau has begun a new construction project on SW 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue near SW Chestnut. The project will last about 10 months and the work will involve making pipe connections to three existing Burlingame water storage tanks at 6932 SW 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. *Streets that will be affected include SW 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, SW Chestnut Street, and SW Burlingame Avenue.* There's going to be noise, dust, and use of heavy equipment and vehicles Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. Neighbors have been notified but we wanted to ensure all schools in the area were aware of the project in case bus routes are affected. #### 2013 COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS

The biennial Nestlé Very Best in Youth program was created to spotlight the best in youth leadership by identifying and honoring teenagers in the United States whose community service efforts are making a profound difference in the lives of others. #### **GRANTS FOR SERVICE-LEARNING PROJECTS TO COMBAT CHILDHOOD OBESITY**

Youth Service America and UnitedHealthcare invite schools and other community-based nonprofit organizations to "step into service" by applying for UnitedHealth HEROES grants. Grants of up to \$1,000 are available for youth-led service-learning projects that aim to combat childhood obesity through walking, running, or hiking. Proposals must include an activity element where young people can count their steps, as well as a service component that provides direct service, enables advocacy on behalf of a cause, or features youth philanthropy. Service-learning projects engage young people in performing service to the community as they gain new knowledge about the issue they are addressing (childhood obesity), and acquire important college, career, and workforce readiness skills in the process. Each UnitedHealth HEROES project will begin on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service (Jan 21, 2013) and end on Global Youth Service Day (April 26-28, 2013). Youth Service America will hold webinars to help applicants through the application process and answer questions. The first webinar will be held Sept 13, 2012. Deadline: Oct 15, 2012. #### TEEN DRIVER SAFETY SERVICE-LEARNING GRANTS

Project Ignition, a student-led teen driver safety program funded by <u>State Farm</u> and coordinated by the <u>National Youth Leadership Council</u>, has announced the availability of grants for public high schools to help students address teen driver safety through service-learning. The project, now in its ninth year, offers grants to students and their advisors interested in creating awareness campaigns focused on teen driver safety while using service-learning — a teaching method that combines meaningful community service with classroom instruction. Youth-led teams host events, form community-wide partnerships, work on local and state policy, produce public service announcements, and more. Twenty-five schools will be chosen to receive \$2,000 grants to implement their campaigns from Jan to April 2013. Ten of these schools will be given the opportunity to receive an additional \$2,500 to continue their campaigns during the 2013-14 school year. These ten schools will receive an additional \$5,000 to support their participation in the National Service-Learning Conference, hosted by NYLC. Deadline: Nov 15, 2012. #### NATIONAL SCIENCE TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION TECHNOLOGY AWARDS

Vernier Software & Technology and the National Science Teachers' Association are accepting applications for the annual Vernier/NSTA Technology Awards. The 2013 awards program will recognize up to seven STEM educators — including one elementary teacher, two middle school teachers, three high school teachers, and one college-level educator — who promote the innovative use of data-collection technology using a computer, graphing calculator, or other handheld in the science classroom. Last year's winners represented a wide range of data-collection activities, including collecting wind speed data, investigating of varying light levels in different environments, designing a walking robot, and building an audio-frequency working model of a phased-array radar. For this year's program, Vernier and NSTA have increased the technology and cash prizes for each winning educator. Prizes include \$1,000 in cash, \$3,000 in Vernier products, and up to \$1,500 toward expenses to attend the 2013 NSTA National Conference in San Antonio, Texas. Award recipients will be chosen based on their application, which is judged by a panel of NSTA-appointed experts. Applicants may be self-nominated or nominated by a colleague. Deadline: Nov 30, 2012.
