



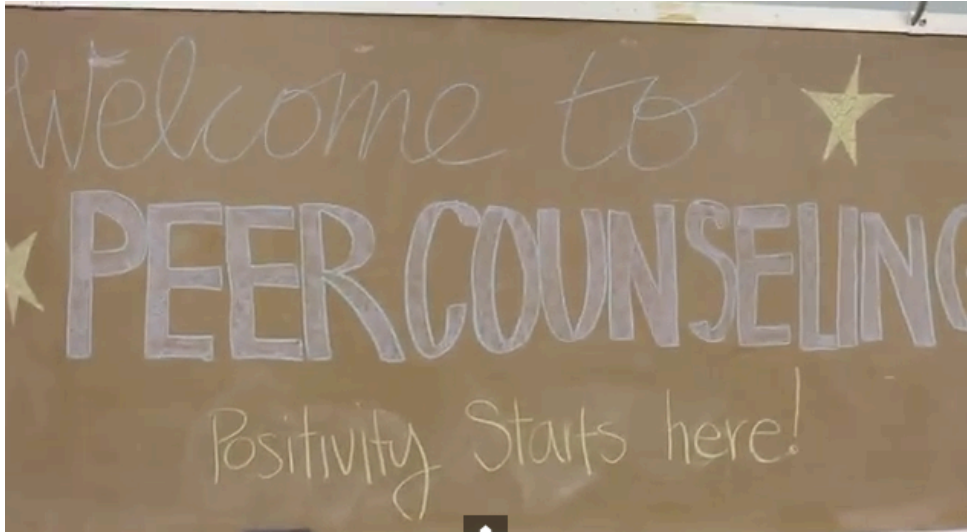

### **WILSON SABER FENCER SELECTED FOR JUNIOR OLYMPICS**

Congratulations to **Ben Scholl '17** for his bronze medal in the Junior Men's Saber event at the Oregon Junior Olympic Qualifier held in December. This earns Ben the chance to compete in the Junior Olympics Fencing Championship competition, to be held in Portland on February 14-17<sup>th</sup> at the convention center. Ben will be competing in three Men's Saber events: Junior Team, Cadet (Under 17 years old) and Junior (Under 20 years old). Fencers from all over the United States were selected based on qualifying competitions in their home states or by accumulated National competition points. Each event has about 150 competitors, and Oregon has about 8 Saber fencers who qualified.
