Senior **Francesca Ierulli,** Cross Country: Francesca set a new Wilson High School record with a time of 18:26 and a 7th-place finish at the Elite Northwest Classic in Eugene. She is currently 10th in the state with her current time—a 5:55 mile pace! We March On!

Jennifer Satalino of The College Place Oregon will be our guest speaker and financial aid guru. She will walk through all of the ways to pay for college including Oregon-specific grants, loans, scholarship searching, and most importantly an indepth look at the gateway to financial aid form—the FAFSA.

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) opens up on October 1 this year. The FAFSA form is used by colleges to process your financial aid package, including grant money. Some scholarships also require you to have filed a FAFSA form, so all students should file the FAFSA even if you do not think you qualify for financial aid.
