- Kindergarten students eat in their classrooms.

TRANSPORTATION





- School buses run in the morning and afternoon.
- Students can be picked up at the school. Guardians park and pick up their student at a designated spot.
- Some students attend the aftercare program, <u>SCCA</u>.

- Teachers or other school staff escort kindergarten students to all after-school destinations including buses and after-school activities.
