## **Finding the Positives Around Us**





#### Let's Get Reading! Update

Let's Get Reading! book bag distribution will continue through the month of January. Please see the attached calendar for current pick up dates. As we approach the end of the quarter later this month, now is an excellent time to review your child's assignment completion in Canvas. Please note that students need to complete at least four (4) weekly activity logs to earn a grade of Pass for their library course grade in Quarter 2. If students are not able to complete the required number of logs, their report card will reflect "no grade."

#### Vernon Book Club

We continue to offer weekly book club meetings for each grade level, and all students are welcome to join us at any time.

Students in grades K-2 are welcome to join us on Tuesdays from 2:15-2:45. We'll have a chance to share books we are reading, and also to hear a story or two.

In grades 3-5 we continue to enjoy a variety of books, including some titles from the OBOB and Reading is Resistance book lists. Students are completing their work with *El Deafo* by CeCe Bell. Starting in February, we will begin reading *Dragons in a Bag* by Zetta Elliott. We'd love you to join us for our weekly meetings on Thursdays at 3:30-4:15!

MYP students are meeting for a weekly book club on Thursday mornings from 8:45-9:30. Currently, we are reading *The Justice Project* by Michael Betcherman. It's not too late to join us if you would like to participate!
