Hi, I'm Jane Johnston, the new Garden Coordinator. I'd like to introduce myself.

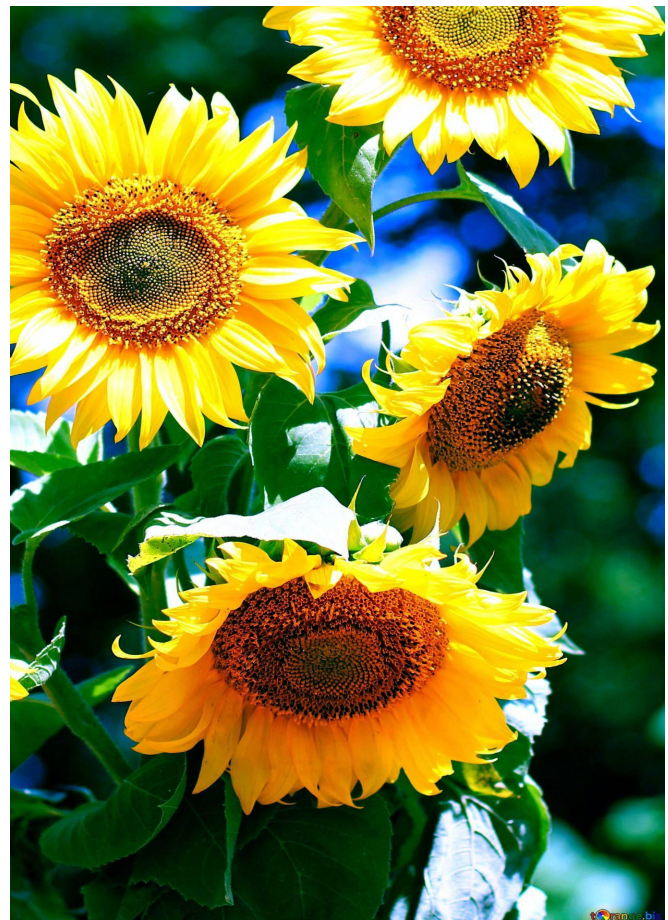
I am a retired elementary school teacher who has taught third through sixth grade in the North Clackamas School District. I also taught sixth grade math and science in a middle school there.

LEAGUE BOUNDARY

- Your league boundary is a perimeter that your neighborhood Little League serves. In order to participate on a Little League team, you must reside within the boundary or attend school in the boundary.

HOW TO REGISTER

- To register, click on the link from the league you reside in. Every website is different, but the league should have a visible tab to register.

FINDING YOUR LEAGUE

- To find the league you belong to, match up your residential zip code OR the school your child attends.
- You can also enter your home or school address into LittleLeague.org's "League Finder Tool":

ABOUT FRIENDS OF BASEBALL

Friends of Baseball is a non-profit organization, committed to increasing access to baseball and softball, especially for underserved youth. Friends of Baseball is affiliated with Major League Baseball's RBI Program. The Full Count RBI after school and summer program has served over 1,200 youth through a baseball-inspired curriculum that includes physical recreation, academic, and socio emotional enrichment activities. - Congrats! Your child is now in your leagues player pool. The player pool is the amount of children signed up for the division. After this, you no longer have to do anything on your end. Your child will get drafted by a coach and they will contact you around the end of February.
