

Multnomah County Library Connect

Starting on May 18, Vernon students can now access books through the Multnomah County



Library through their Library Connect Program – no library card required! Students can use their PPS student ID number and birthday to access the library catalog, place holds for books, and check out materials. If your child already has a library card, they can continue to use that if they prefer.
