COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINICS



At Multnomah County COVID-19 vaccine clinics:

- The vaccines will be provided at no cost to you.
- You do not need health insurance.
- You do not need to bring proof of eligibility, identification or a social security number in order to get a vaccine.
- Everyone 18+ is eligible for the vaccines.
- Most clinics can vaccinate ages 12 years and up. Check the website <u>multco.us/vaccineclinics</u> or call 503.988.8939 to find out if a vaccine will be available at the clinic for youth 12 17 and to find out what else you need to know about vaccines for this age group.

These events are focused on serving African American, Black, Afro-Carribean, Latinx, African/Black Immigrants and Refugees, and other people/communities of color. Everyone is welcome.


