Students and families are responsible for the proper use and care of their student assigned Chromebook.

- Food or drink should not be next to Chromebooks
- Chromebooks should be carried closed and held securely with two hands
- Chromebooks should not be used or stored near pets
- · Heavy objects should never be placed on top of Chromebooks
- Chromebooks must remain free of any writing, drawing, permanent stickers, and labels that would alter the appearance of the Chromebook
- Chromebooks should never be loaned to another student or individual and student accounts should never be shared

Students and families are also responsible for understanding and following the PPS Responsible Use Policy:

Do Not...

- Share private information about yourself or others.
- · Cause harm to others or damage to their property.
- · Damage computer equipment, data or files.
- Pursue hacking.
- · Copy or download copyrighted materials.
- Look at, send, copy or create material that is rude, inappropriate or meant to hurt someone's feelings.
- Steal information or music.
- Buy, sell or advertise merchandise unless it's part of a project.
- · Install software on computers unless approved by teacher or District staff.

Be Aware...

- Only current students can use the District network. Your privilege of using technology
 can be taken away by staff or parents if you are engaging in inappropriate behavior.
- Understand the choices you make while on a computer or the internet. Tell an adult if you see something threatening or inappropriate happening.
