Student Tech Devices

Every PPS student grades three to twelve has access to a free tech device to access digital curriculum and online resources. If your student needs a device, please contact your school. You will be expected to sign an User Agreement acknowledging that you received a device.

Please note that PPS is removing the \$20 device self-insurance fee that was previously announced by school communities.
