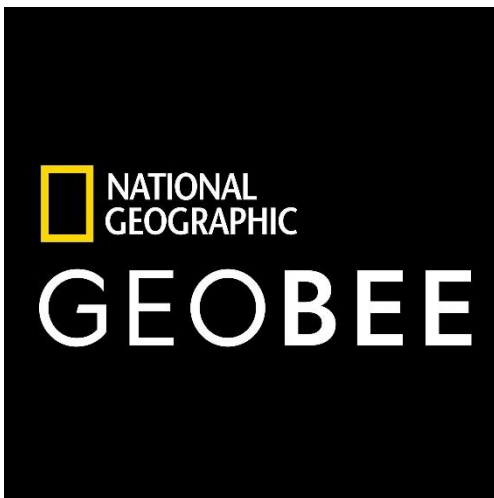


The National Geographic GeoBee
