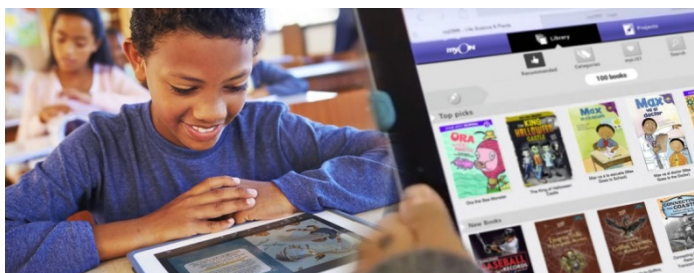
We are proud to inform you our school is implementing an exciting, new literacy program called MyOn! As a benefit, students can use MyOn at home. Here's how you get started:
