

Dual Assignment/Enrollment

Most Vernon students have the choice between two High Schools (depending on their home address). Those options are: McDaniels, Roosevelt, or Grant AND Jefferson.

Students need to make their choice by <u>December 17</u>. If they do not pick, a High School will be picked for them by the District.
