If they do not pick, a High School will be picked for them by the District.

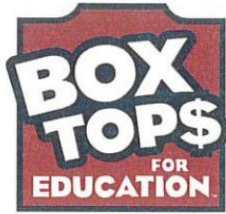

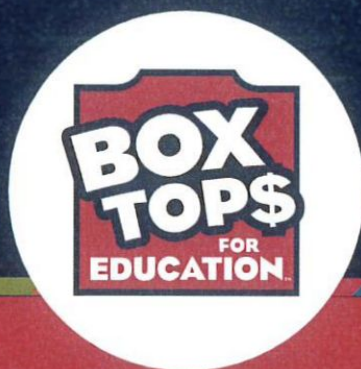
