<u>Auditions</u>: Tuesday, December 6th <u>3rd grade and up</u> will take place in the music room with 8th grade directors and teachers only. Be expected to audition a few lines from the script, and sing.

Final scripts go home with actors on Friday, December 16th.

Dialogue and music will need to be worked on over winter break.
