

# Celebrate Amazing Activist Artwork!

3rd and 5th graders have been creating incredible suminagashi collages to educate the Vernon community about Line 3, which is one of the largest crude oil pipelines in the world, carrying up to 915,000 barrels per day of one of the dirtiest fuels, tar sands. The pipeline goes through Michigan and the White Earth reservation, which is Ojibwe and Anishinaabe land. Line 3 threatens the water they drink and the wild rice they harvest, as well as worsening the climate crisis for all. The amazing students were inspired to write letters to the Governor of Minnesota to ask him to stop the pipeline and to protect their futures! 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# **Dual Assignment/Enrollment**

Most Vernon students have the choice between two High Schools (depending on their home address). Those options are: McDaniels, Roosevelt, or Grant AND Jefferson.

Students need to make their choice by <u>December 22nd</u>. If they do not pick, a High School will be picked for them by the District.
