Please note that Portland Public Schools has set the deadline to return library books for Friday, June 3. The coming holiday weekend is a great time to check backpacks, bedrooms, and favorite reading spots for any library books your child may have borrowed recently.

If you've received a reminder about a book you've already turned in, please contact Mrs. Wilkins at <u>jwilkins@pps.net</u> so we can correct the issue. If a library book is lost, there are a few great options available to you.

Option 1: Bring a replacement: Students are welcome to bring a new or gently used book as a replacement for the lost one. Replacement books need not be the same title, but any book in good condition that someone else may enjoy will work great. Place a sticky note on the front indicating their name and that it is a replacement so l can delete the library fine.
