Volunteers of all ages are welcome! We will be working with Depave who will provide all the necessary tools, safety gear, ice water, snacks and lunch. Orientation starts at 9:45am and we'll be working until around noon – 1pm at the latest.

Due to the physical nature of asphalt removal, volunteers are encouraged to wear long pants and clothing appropriate for tough work. Closed-toe shoes are required to depave – NO EXCEPTIONS.
