The StudentVue account will be activated during the first weeks of school. ANNUAL REGISTRATION

STUDENT VERIFICATION FORMS

In order to keep our student records current, we kindly request an annual review of the enclosed PPS enrollment documents. Please review all information carefully and:

- If the information is current please sign, date and return to school along with all the other paperwork by Friday, September 13th
- If the information is not current and accurate, please make changes on the form itself. If the change is that of an address, include two proofs that show the new address. Addresses will not be updated without the

two proofs. Acceptable proofs of address include, mortgage statement, rental agreement, county tax bill, rental insurance statements or utility bills. Please return all paperwork to school by September 13th.

ATTENDANCE

All absences must be cleared by a parent/guardian. On day of absence call the main office at 503 916 5690 and leave a message on the attendance line and please include the student's *full and legal name* and reason for absence. If your child needs to leave during the school day, please send them to school with a note for the main office and they will be cleared to leave class at that time. Phone calls to release students from class are disruptive to the entire classroom and should be avoided.

BUSES

Please send a note with your student if they plan to take a different bus home from school or will be getting off at a different stop. All bus notes need to be turned into the main office upon arriving at school.
