Educator Update:

Unfortunately, we did have to start the school year with an unfilled half-time teaching position in the 6th Grade. We have been fortunate to have a consistent substitute Educator running the three classes (labeled as Mr. Keller on the schedule) while we search for an Educator to join the WSMS team. The 6th Grade Math and Science Educators are collaborating with our Substitute to be sure that our scholars have appropriate pacing and lessons in the meanwhile. We are working hard to try to find talented candidates to interview for this opening.

Schedule Questions:

Our Administrative team has been working through the schedule issues that were sent to us at westsylvanoffice@pps.net. If you still see possible errors in a schedule, such as missing Math or World Language or inaccurate classes, those changes can be addressed. For Math acceleration, if an acceleration was not approved last Spring, your scholar will need to wait until assessment data is gathered throughout the first quarter to see if they are eligible for acceleration. Math Educators will also be doing some pre-assessments in the coming weeks to start gathering data.

Safety updates:

Masking is not mandatory at this time, but continues to be recommended. Scholars and Educators are welcome to choose whether or not to wear a mask based on individual needs and preferences. We continue to recommend physical distancing, and all PPS updates can be found on the main <u>PPS website</u>. Scholars are still allowed to eat outdoors. We simply designate a space near the Upper Gym for those with a preference to eat outdoors. Should your scholar have a question about outdoor eating, they can find any adult supervising lunch for more information.

Electronics Policy:



The cell phone policy changes have been going well so far! The few scholars who have been on their phones throughout the day have them placed in the office to pick up at the end of the day. WSMS is a <u>cell phone free zone from 9:00 AM - 3:45 PM</u> daily. We request and advise all families to keep scholars' cell phones at home during the school day. If a scholar brings a cell phone to school, they will be expected to store their turned-off phone in their locker throughout the *entire* school day (including lunches). Important messages can be sent to our main office via email at <u>westsylvanoffice@pps.net</u> and emails will be forwarded to your scholars. Time will be allowed for students to check their emails during the last period of the day.

Cafeteria/Menus:

Students are welcome to bring their own sack lunch and are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle daily to refill throughout the school day. WSMS received an upgrade to our water fountains, and we are using refillable temporary water stations while these upgrades are being finalized.

This year, Scholars will have to pay for school breakfast and lunch, and information about plans and assistance can be found on the PPS Nutrition Services webpage <u>here</u>.
