# Safety Updates:

Last Friday, there were two safety issues, one with a 6th grade family member and another with a few of our 8th graders. The Beaverton Police sent an officer to greet our families on Monday morning only as a show of support with our community. The officer was just on campus for a short time in the morning. To help address any rumors or concerns, the officer was *not* invited to campus due to ongoing safety concerns *or* school safety threats. Our BPD officers are community partners for safety response, as we are located within the city of Beaverton. I told Educators the same information, in case Scholars asked why this person was around.

As a result of the Friday issue with a few of our 8th graders, there was an uptick in many untrue rumors circulating. Each concerning statement has been investigated by myself and our Counselors, and there is no credible evidence of any threat to safety for our scholars. Also, we have spent time in Advisory reteaching the importance of being an upstander. We have also been emphasizing the dangers of inappropriate social media posts, and the impact of untrue gossiping on the lives of others. We continue referring scholars to Counseling and mental health providers when needs are identified. The SafeOregon reporting site is another way to report concerns so that they are investigated.
