Bell Schedule Shift in January:

When we return to school in January, we will be using the "Morning Advisory" bell schedule (see below). We are shifting to this version of our bell schedule in January to dedicate time at the start of each day to reteach many schoolwide expectations and to focus on some important Social-Emotional lessons with our Scholars at the start of each school day. Re-engaging in school after a break can be a challenge, and we want to start the days with some lessons to reconnect and reestablish community each morning during January. The amount of time spent in instruction remains the same, and the Advisory class will be at the start of the day, rather than the end.

Social Media and Vacation:

Two weeks away from school may mean extra time on social media for young people. We typically see an uptick in conflicts between Scholars and reports of bullying and harassment after long periods of time when

Scholars are allowed to engage in more free time on social media than usual. Please monitor your Scholars' social media accounts and chats to ensure that they are engaging in safe behaviors. Help Scholars block negative accounts and log off from chats and groups that are detrimental to their emotional safety and well being.

WSMS 2022-2023 Yearbook Orders:

Each year our Yearbook class, with Educator Mr. Gilley, creates the school yearbook. To order the 2022-23 yearbook, go to <u>yearbookordercenter.com</u>, and enter code **6339**. All sales of the yearbook will be <u>preordered</u> directly through an outside company and will <u>not</u> be available for purchase through the school at the end of the school year. Applications need to be submitted by the deadline for consideration for any school outside of your normal PPS neighborhood boundary: https://www.pps.net/schoolchoice. There is a deadline for applications, so please apply early if you are requesting a high school outside of your address boundaries.

Applying to Benson Lottery for the 2023-24 School Year: We will be accepting applications for Benson from Tuesday, November 15 to Friday, December 16th. Students only have to complete one on-line application. The online application will be on the Enrollment website: https://www.pps.net/schoolchoice. Students are usually informed of acceptance by the end of January/beginning of February. We will have an in person and online forecasting nights about mid February for students who have been accepted.

Reporting Safety Concerns During Vacation:

While school is on a break, report safety concerns to your local police department for emergencies and call 911 for immediate medical and safety emergencies. <u>The SafeOregon</u> reporting site is another way to report concerns so that they are investigated when school resumes. 211 is another number for various community resources.

Inclement Weather Preparation:

School District leaders will assess each morning to determine if cold weather or winter conditions have made roads for travel unsafe for families and buses. Based on assessments, District leaders will announce if buses are on Snow Routes or if there is a change in schedule for schools (a <u>late start</u> or school cancellation). There will be automated messages sent out based on the contact information in our ParentVue data. Please ensure that you are updating your contact information if cell numbers or contacts have changed.

Marking Attendance through ParentVue

Families are now able to record future absences for their Students directly in ParentVUE without needing to contact the Main Office. Please remember, if a student is going to miss multiple days, it is up to the Student and/or Parent/Guardian to communicate absences with each teacher and make a plan for missing work and assignments.

If your Student is going to be Absent for a **FULL DAY:**

Log in to the ParentVUE website or download and open the phone application. In either case, look for the 'Report Absence' button to the right of your Student's photograph. Select start date, end date, and a reason from the drop-down list. Remember to click SAVE, and you should receive a popup confirmation.

If your Student is Absent for a **PARTIAL DAY**:

Send an email to westsylvanoffice@pps.net with the date, times, and reason.
