We are a couple of weeks into the 2022-23 school year, and we are looking forward to sharing items with families through a couple formats next week for **Back-To-School Night.** For those of you who have visited our campus, you already know how limited parking is, and we acknowledge that there will simply be *many* challenges with visiting campus on Wednesday evening due to the unfortunate lack of space to park in our school parking lot and in surrounding areas.

By Tuesday, we will share virtual slides from our Educators, our Administrative team, and our Counselors so that all families who prefer to avoid the traffic can hear information virtually. These will be pre-recorded videos/slides that families can watch on their own time, depending on their schedules.

For families visiting campus in-person, you will want to have access to ParentVue on your phone so that you can "follow" your scholar's schedule to visit classes by period. There will be ten minutes per period to meet Educators (twenty minutes for Block classes), during which time you will hear an overview of the class offerings from the Educator. Later in the Fall there will be virtual Fall Conferences which are designed for individual student conferencing with Educators, so BTSN is not designed for individual conferences. It is an evening to see the campus, meet Educators, and to hear a larger overview about each class in your scholar's schedule. Our Foundation members will have information to share about ways to get involved, and some student clubs may sell school merchandise.

## Transportation:

Please consider allowing your scholar to ride the bus rather than picking up and dropping off each day, as much as possible! Bus transportation has been much better this year than last year. There are still a couple buses that have been late on days while the drivers get accustomed to their routes or due to traffic. Educators do not penalize scholars for a late arrival on a bus.

When buses are going to be late arriving in the afternoon, our office will send a mass communication to families so that you are not alarmed.

When dropping off or picking up scholars, please take care to respect our neighbors. Many of them post signs and even put out cones in front of their driveways to remind families to avoid parking in their driveways and trespassing on their property. No Parking zones and signs should be followed, as I just met with Beaverton PD and they will issue citations for ignoring the signage. Our neighbors ask for your cooperation and civility in drop-off and pick up so that families are not blocking their driveways and impeding traffic from passing in streets. Having scholars use the buses eliminates all need to interact with the neighbors!

## **Electronics Policy:**



The cell phone policy changes have been going well so far! The few scholars who have been on their phones throughout the day have them held in the Office to pick up at the end of the day. WSMS is a <u>cell phone free zone from 9:00 AM - 3:45 PM</u> daily. We request and advise all families to keep scholars' cell phones at home during the school day. If a scholar brings a cell phone to school, they will be expected to store their turned-off phone in their locker throughout the *entire* school day (including lunches). Important messages can be sent to our main office via email at

westsylvanoffice@pps.net and emails will be forwarded to your scholars. Time will be allowed for students to check their emails during the last period of the day.

### Cafeteria/Menus:

Students are welcome to bring their own sack lunch and are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle daily to refill throughout the school day. WSMS received an upgrade to our water fountains, and they now feature bottle-filling stations.

This year, Scholars will have to pay for school breakfast and lunch, and information about plans and assistance can be found on the PPS Nutrition Services webpage <u>here</u>. Our Office has been experiencing heavy family traffic prior to our 3:45PM dismissal, due to daily early pick-ups. Whenever possible, we ask that you <u>avoid picking up your scholar between 3:15PM and 3:45PM</u>, as our Office becomes overwhelmed with accommodating early pick-ups and Staff is limited in the afternoons. Any planning around that timeframe is appreciated. **If you need to pick up early, we kindly request that you try to arrive prior to 3:15PM.** Please be prepared to show your photo ID, as it is a legal requirement for picking up Scholars during school hours.
