


IDA B WELLS-BARNETT HS CAREER LEARNING 21-22



In the 2021-2022 school year, **1,290 IBWHS students¹** participated in more than **70 career learning opportunities**. Events and activities were facilitated by IBW's career coordinator, teachers, students/affinity clubs, in collaboration with PPS CTE personnel and/or external industry partners (See list in [Appendix 1](#)).

As we continued to navigate pandemic protocols, career learning included both virtual and in-person events, both on and off campus, and spanned the continuum of career awareness, career exploration, and career preparation including work based learning. →

Virtual district wide events promoting career awareness and postsecondary planning continued to have a high reach and impact. These included Tools to Build Your Future (Fall 2021) and Plan, Do, Act (Spring 2022), which coincided with district testing days. These and other events contributed to student college and career readiness and progress toward graduation requirements including career related learning experiences (CRLEs).

Student & Classroom Supports

To cultivate relationships and to inform students of available resources, opportunities, and graduation requirements, College & Career Center staff opened our doors wide and conducted outreach to students in all grade levels, pushing into classes including **CCE, CTE, AVID, SpEd, EBL, Sophomore US History, Junior and Senior English**. The CCC regularly supported **AVID** students and facilitated the following content specific workshops:

- Introduction to College & Career
- Exploring Careers & Post-Secondary Options
- Internships
- Entrepreneurial mindset and the elevator pitch
- Resume Workshop
- Mock Interviewing (AVID 10)
- Volunteering 101
- And regular push-ins to share opportunities including college/post-secondary visits, career presentations, mentoring, internships, jobs, etc.

Junior English teachers were supported with a Canvas Resume unit to support students' personal writing, confidence and articulation of skills with **251** resumes submitted.

As a result of a strong partnership with Sr English teachers, case managers, counselors, and Class of 2022 VP, the career coordinator was able to tackle low personalized learning requirement completion rates at the beginning of 21-22 to ensure every Senior fulfilled these requirements to graduate. Working in collaboration with college coordinators, each Senior developed a plan for life *after* Ida B Wells.
