  - a. Travis is the SUN Director, he is also in charge of the Food Pantry.
- 5. The Food Pantry is going into a new location in the south wing of Lane in a space next to the School Health Center.
  - a. This will help with getting the Health Center noticed.
- **6.** This year Lane has many new teachers; all great hirers. There is a lot of excitement for Lane this year. Some teachers/staff new to Lane and returning this year have made the comment that the school seems calmer/quitter than in years past.
