Beaumont's UnAuction

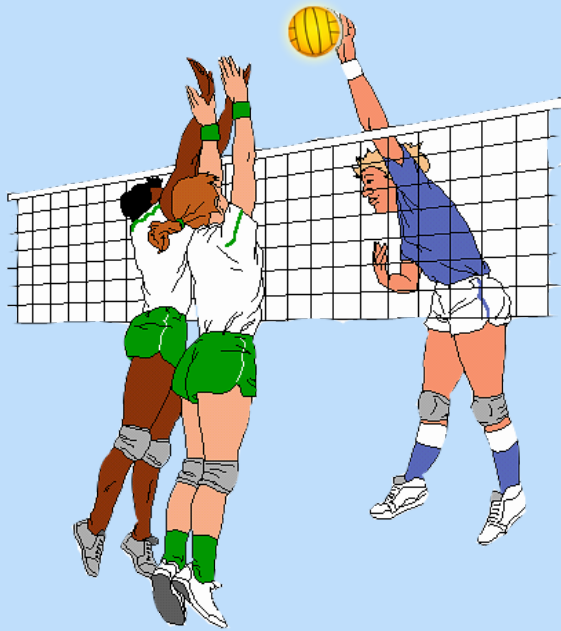
The Beaumont Foundation has been working pretty dang hard to put together a memorable and successful 2019 UnAuction. We've been hustling the streets of Portland but could use your help.

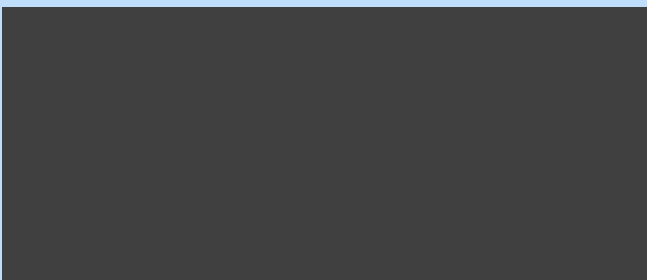
