Two Summer Programs for Incoming Ninth Graders

Ninth Grade Counts is a summer program for students entering 9th grade in fall 2019. It gives students an opportunity to get a jump on their journey through high school. This no cost program runs from July 8-August 1. Students meet Monday- Thursday to review high school requirements, explore college and career possibilities, and gain new academic skills all while learning about Native American art and teachings. Students will go on field trips to various locations on Tuesdays and Thursdays including an overnight trip at the end of the program to a University. Students may receive .5 high school elective credit and may

complete one Career Related Learning Experience (a graduation requirement for many students) during the summer program. If you would like your child to participate please<u>complete the application</u> and *turn it in by May 30th.*

Leap Into 9th Grade is a summer program for incoming freshmen that helps them prepare to be successful in high school. Students will meet teachers and classmates, explore different career paths, earn .5 elective credit, and learn to be confident in learning math.
