Beaumont Cafeteria News for All Families

Starting this school year, the kitchen will be offering each student the opportunity to purchase one breakfast and one lunch per day. Students will not be able to purchase additional meals or milk.

This new process supports the District's wellness policy, as well as Portland's sustainability efforts. The policy will also help reduce confusion around use of school meal funds on the student's account. For example, charging additional meals and/or milk without parent knowledge and approval.

Water is freely available in the cafeteria during lunch and milk will still be offered as a part of a complete meal. As always, unlimited fruits and veggies are available to students purchasing school lunch.
