Attention 8th grade parents if you are interested in submitting a baby ad, you have until February 15th to do this. You can do this on school pay as well. It has become more and more of a tradition here at Beaumont with each year more and more ads, so don't delay, submit today. I will not be able to extend the deadline this year. Here's what I'll need:

Baby Ad Process

- 1. Find an adorable photo of your child as a baby / toddler.
- 2. Get the photo to Ms. Bennett; either hard copy via her mailbox in the Beaumont office OR email as an attachment:

- 3. Include a message on the back of the photo or in the body of the email. Maximum of 2 simple sentences, better if it's less than 2.
- 4. Pay for the ad \$15. I prefer submitting through your school pay account. This is ONLY live for 8th grade families. Or put paper copy of Yearbook order form in Ms. Bennett's mailbox in the office note on the bottom of order form "purchased baby ad" on the "white space" at the bottom. This is also a great place to submit your message if you're not doing digital.
- 5. If hardcopy please include a phone number to contact you so that you can pick up the photo.

We will be set up at conferences to purchase your Yearbook and Baby Ad, so bring cash or checkbook. Yearbooks on sale for \$20. Prices going up after Thanksgiving. Or, I'm fully supporting the school pay method. Please go onto your school pay account and purchase a yearbook that way, you'll be able to view your payment. Please note that if your student has a yearbook purchased by Feb. 28, I do everything within my power to guarantee a photo in the book, beyond the traditional school photo. So purchasing early is a bonus. Yearbook prices increase will be increasing as the year goes on!

Information packets with tentative itineraries are available in the main office literature rack. This is a good time to start the online registration and payment process (instructions below). Here is a snapshot of the trip:

Night flight departing Friday, June 15, 2018, returning evening Thursday, June 21, 2018. 6 days/5 nights. Destinations include: Washington, DC, Gettysburg, PA, Philadelphia, PA, and New York, NY. Price estimate is \$3097.00. Price includes: roundtrip airfare, evening activities, all meals, all admission fees, quality lodging (quad occupancy), nighttime security, on-site escort, motorcoach transportation, and tour guides/motorcoach drivers.

This tour is designed by Educational Travel Services, Inc. (ETSI, a family-owned local travel agency) for middle school-age participants, and will give you a close look at our nation's history and heritage. I will chaperone this trip with other teacher chaperones, as needed. This is NOT a schoolsponsored trip.
