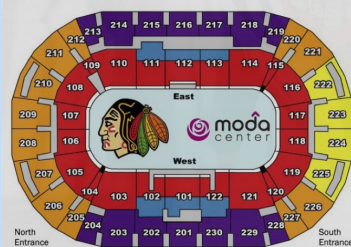

Nurse's Notes:

From Jennifer, RN: Immunization notifications will be sent this week. Many middle school students are due for their Tdap booster. The days off from school in November and December could be a good time to get immunizations.

Health providers will also discuss HPV. It is not required for school, but CDC now recommends 11 to 12 year olds get two doses of HP vaccine—rather than the previously recommended three doses—to protect against cancers caused by HPV. The second dose should be given 6-12 months after the first dose. 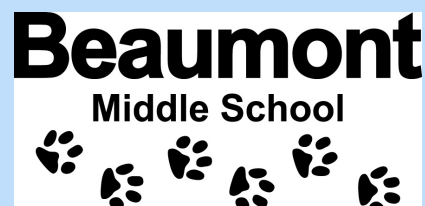
